501c3

Tax Exemption: 501c3 nonprofit organizations are exempt from federal income tax if they have a purpose related to Religious, Educational, Charitable, Scientific, Literary, Testing for Public Safety, to Foster National or International Amateur Sports Competition, or Prevention of Cruelty to Children or Animal Organizations.

Grants: A 501c3 nonprofit may receive grants from foundations.

Donations: Donations to a 501c3 organization are tax deductible for the donor to the full extent of the law.

501c4

Tax Exemption: 501c4 organizations are not necessarily exempt from federal income tax. These organizations are Civic Leagues, Social Welfare Organizations and Local Associations of Employees.

Donations: Donations to a 501c4 organization are not usually tax deductible for the donor.

501c6

Tax Exemption: 501c6 organizations are exempt from federal tax income. These organizations are Business Leagues, Chambers of Commerce, Real Estate Boards etc.

Donations: Donations to a 501c6 organization are not tax deductible for the donor.
